SHOWING LOVE TO YOUR HOME AND PETS!

We all love our furry family members, but it's harder to love the mess. Here are some cleaning tips all pet owners need to know!

Regular Grooming: Use a pet-safe shampoo periodically and don't forget to trim nails and hair to mitigate shedding and damage caused by nail scratching. A professional pet groomer could also be beneficial!

Banish Pet Hair: Use rubber dishwashing gloves, duct tape, or StickySheets on any surface to de-fur. For carpets or furniture, invest in a vacuum cleaner designed to remove pet hair and reduce odors.

Dissolve Carpet Stains: Combine baking soda and vinegar for stain removal and odor elimination. Once the solution sets, dab the stain and vacuum once dry. Use a UV black light to locate sneaky accidents!

Tidy Your Pet's Food Area: Pets can be messy eaters! Spilled food pieces can attract ants, so use a pet placemat to keep your pet's eating area tidy. Use tip-proof or elevated food and water dishes to prevent spillage.

Create a Pet Cleaning Station: To combat your pet's tracking in dirt, set up a pet cleaning station near the door to wipe your pet's paws. Stock your station with wipes, towels, and treats, of course!

Furniture Protection: If your pet is allowed on furniture, it may be a good idea to invest in a pet-friendly sofa that's easy to clean. You can also lay throw blankets across your couch to keep it clean. Instead of cleaning the couch, just toss the blankets in the wash!
